Background

Aldi joined ABNR in November 2023. His primary practice areas are **capital markets, mergers & acquisitions (M&A)**, and **general corporate law**.

In **capital markets**, he has been involved in a variety of projects and transactions, including initial public offerings (IPOs), rights issues, medium-term notes (MTN) issuances, establishment of mutual funds, establishment of real estate investment trusts (REITs), and other investment products.

In **M&A**, he has advised a diverse group of clients, from domestic corporations to multinational companies on a wide range of transactions. In 2022, he acted as legal counsel in advising Investree Singapore Pte Ltd, the Singaporean parent company of an Indonesian P2P platform, in acquiring a significant minority stake in PT Bank Amar Indonesia Tbk, a leading digital bank.

In 2021, he assisted PT Bank Permata Tbk with its bank integration of the Indonesian branch operations of Bangkok Bank Public Co Ltd, which involved the issuance of USD 700 million Additional Tier-1 Subordinated Notes and the receipt of a USD 765 million advance capital payment from the Bangkok Bank Public Co Ltd. This marked the first bank integration of a foreign bank's operations under the OJK regulatory framework.

In **general corporate**, he has advised a broad spectrum of corporate matters including joint venture establishment, corporate due diligence, advising on corporate governance, and structuring and negotiating shareholder agreements and other key corporate documents.

Aldi graduated from Padjadjaran University, Bandung, in 2015, majoring in economic law. In 2025, he completed his Master of Laws (LL.M.) degree from the University of Melbourne, Australia, specializing in capital markets and banking and finance laws. He is admitted to the Indonesian Bar Association (PERADI).
